b) $4x^2 + 4y^2 + 4z^2 - 8x + 16y = 1$

⑧ Is the triangle formed by $P(3, -2, -3)$, $Q(7, 0, 1)$, and $R(1, 2, 1)$ a right triangle?

⑨ Describe the following regions in \mathbb{R}^3 :

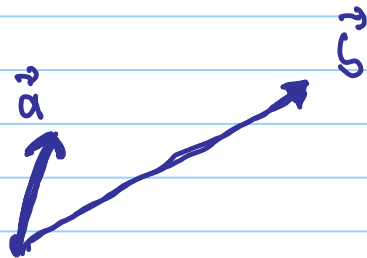
a) $y \geq 0$
