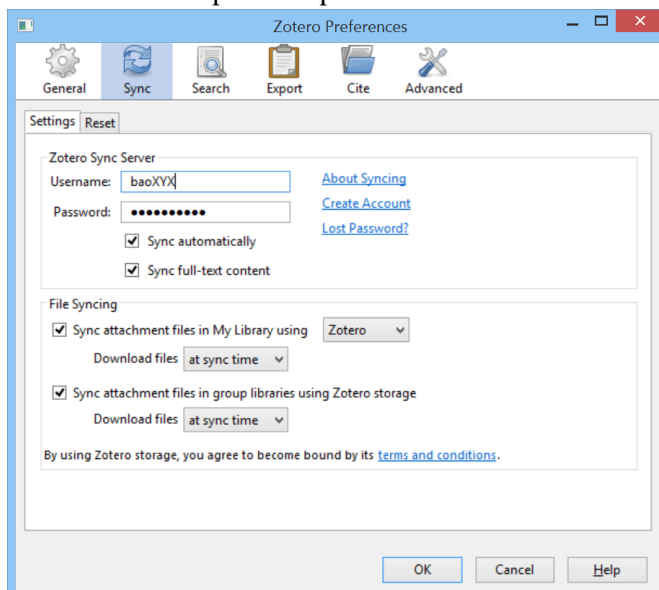

Zotero is bibliographic management tool. It helps a researcher to format their citations in a desired format, e.g. APA, MLA, and Chicago/Turabian styles.

Download, Install and Set up Zotero


1. Download Zotero from <https://www.zotero.org/>
2. Register an account with Zotero so that your save citations can be accessed anywhere in the world.
3. There is a Zotero standalone icon on the desktop after you install it.
4. You need to set up Zotero preferences as shown in the screenshot below:

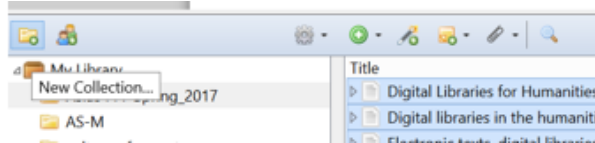


## Capture Citations with Zotero in Firefox

1. Zotero works best with Firefox <https://www.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/>

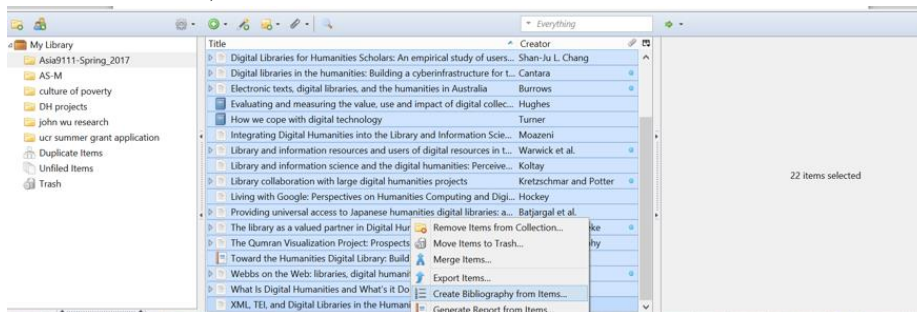


2. Zotero icons are on the Firefox toolbar on the top
3. Click on **Z** to activate Zotero in Firefox.
4. Click on  page or arrow to download citation to Zotero.
5. Click on “New Collection” icon to create a folder for each of your paper assignment

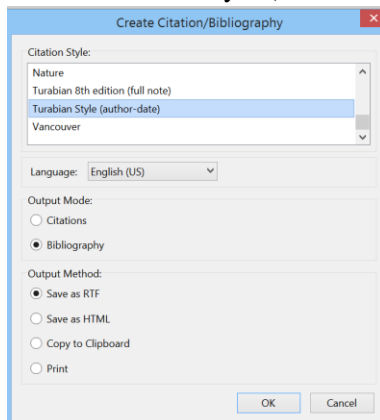


## Create a Bibliography List with Zotero

1. To create a bibliography list, select the items in a folder and click on the right button, (see screenshot below)



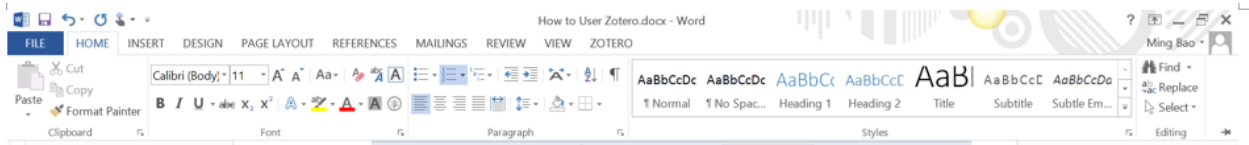
2. Click on “Create Bibliography from Items...”
3. Select Turabian Style (author-date) (See screenshot below)



4. Click OK to give the file a name and destination.
5. Open the RTF file with MS Word, and save it in Word.

## Insert Parenthetical Citations and References in Word

1. There should be a Zotero icon in Word's toolbar once it is installed on your computer.



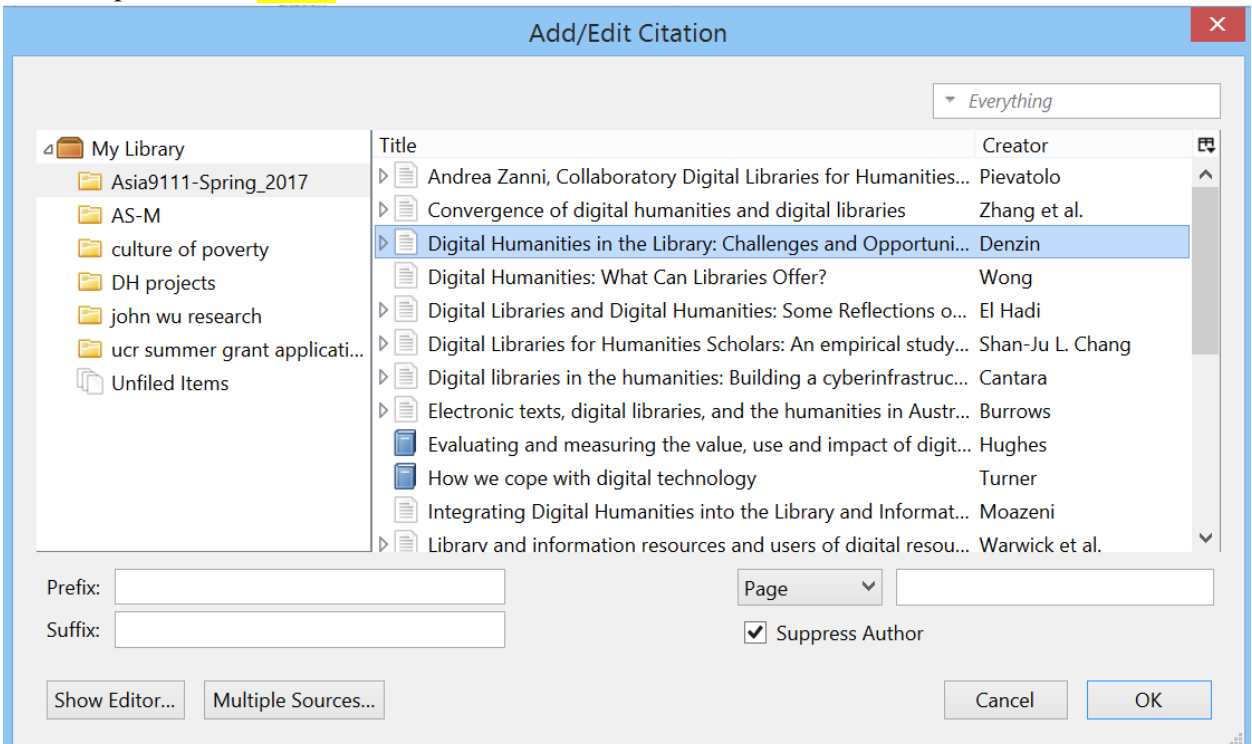
2. You type a quotation or paraphrase
3. Place cursor at the location where you want to insert a citation
4. To insert a citation here (Denzin 2016), click on Zotero icon on Word's toolbar, and click on "Add/Edit Citation" button but you will be asked to activate your Firefox.



5. Click Z-arrow to select "Classic View," and select the citation you want to insert.



6. If you already write author's name to introduce a quote, you can suppress the author's name.
7. For example, Denzin (2016) state: "..."



- To create a reference list, move the cursor to the location where you want the reference to appear, and click on “Insert Bibliography” (see the above screenshot under point 4), for example below:

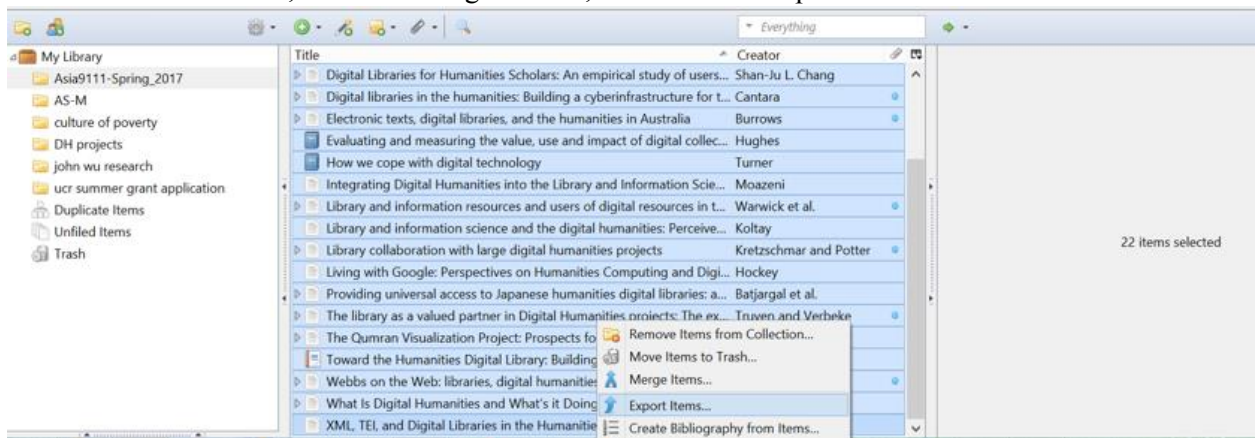

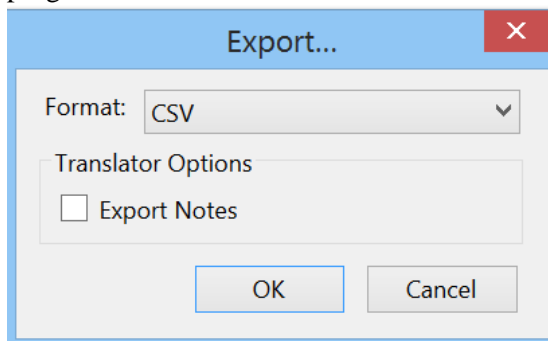
- You can click on “Refresh” to update the reference list if you insert more parenthetical citations.

## Export Zotero Citation Items to Excel

- Select the citation items, click on the right button, and click on “Export Items...”



- Select CSV format, click on OK to give a file name and destination. Open the CSV file Excel program.



- The citation records in Excel can be used for data analysis and visualization on subject keywords, journal names, and year of publication and so on. Microsoft Power BI is a free data visualization tool <https://powerbi.microsoft.com/en-us/>.
